Step 1) Send a call-out using the community newspaper or social media with a simple description.

Example: Are you interested in learning how to use that cell phone or printer? Do you want to know the history of your community or family?

Elders and youth are invited to stop by the library to participate in a digital and historical exchange. Youth will provide answers to your technology-related questions, and elders will bring the old stories!

Step 2) Confirm participation with elders and youth to make sure there is community interest.

Step 3) Open the library at a convenient time. Make sure there are electrical outlets available to plug in devices.
